



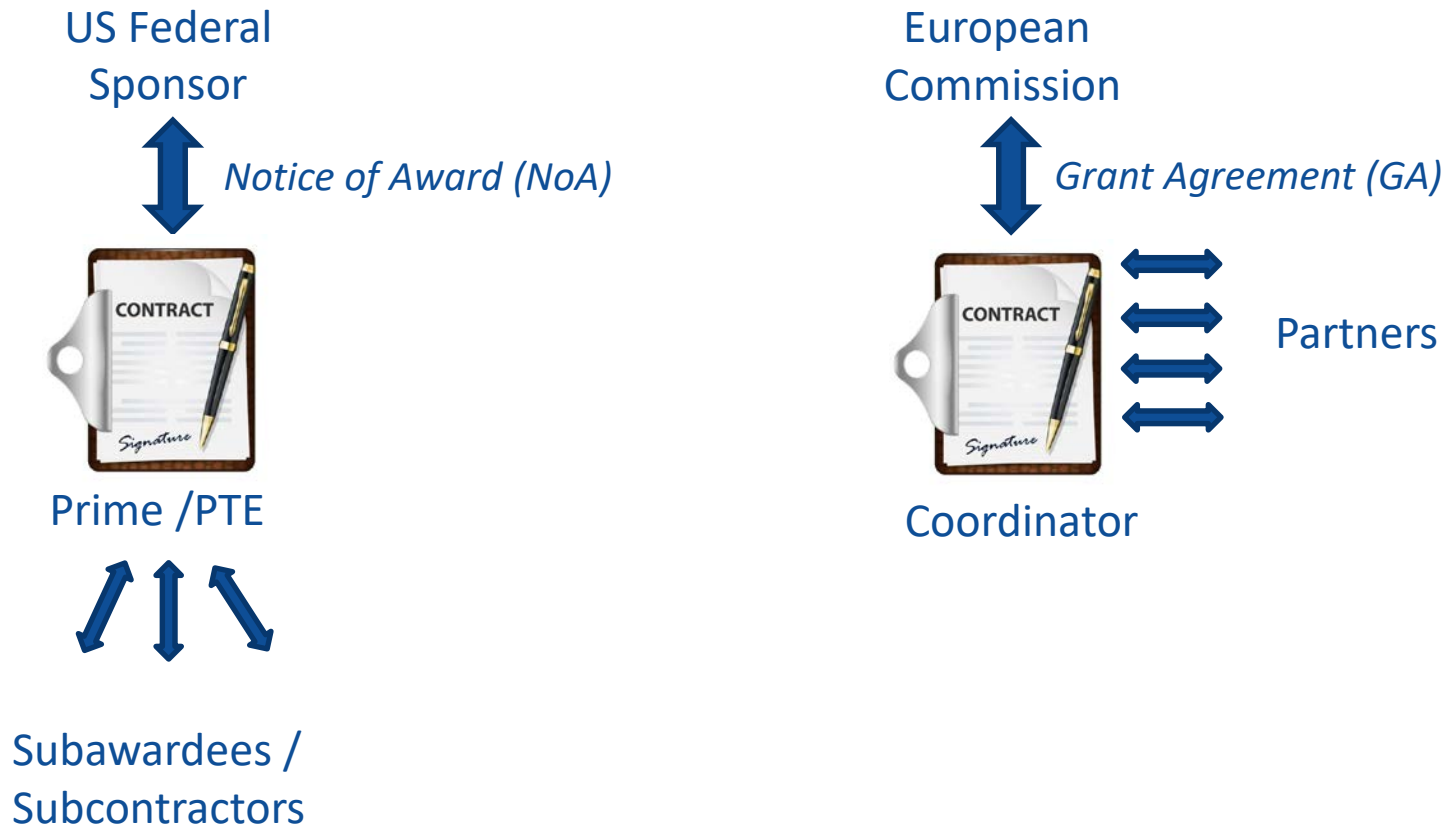

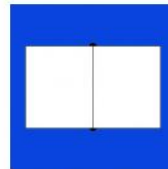
SETTING THE SCENE AND GETTING STARTED

- **Phase 1: Research**
 - Collection of existing EU and US guidance for funding terms and glossaries that are CC
 - Researching to appropriate platform
- **Phase 2: Set-up of a MediaWiki**
 - Concept and logic for using a *Terminology MediaWiki*
 - *Definition of regulations regarding user rights, help function, etc.*
- **Phase 3: Transfer of data into the *Terminology MediaWiki***
 - Allocating each term to the respective “language” (EU or US terminology) and set-up of a common glossary
- **Phase 4: Streamlining content & Testing**
 - Editorial review and corrections of the definitions and assigning transatlantic equivalent terms whenever possible by *EU/US Best Practise Group*
- **Phase 5: Public Launch in the US and EU**
 - Presentation of *Terminology MediaWiki* and workshops on adding and editing during research administrators and research manager conferences

Grant Agreement

A contract concluded between the European Commission (representing the European Union) and the beneficiary (or beneficiaries) under which the parties receive the rights and obligations (e.g. the right of the Union's financial contribution and the obligation to carry out the research and development work). It consists of the basic text and annexes.

More general a *Grant Agreement* is a contract specifying terms and obligations of beneficiaries in a project.

Notice of Award

A legally binding document, notifying the grantee and others that an award has been made, including all terms and conditions of the award and outlining the obligation of Federal funds.

The document is signed (or the electronic equivalent of signature) by a Grants Management Officer that:

1. notifies the recipient of the award of a grant;
2. contains or references all the terms and conditions of the grant and Federal funding limits and obligations; and,
3. provides the documentary basis for recording the obligation of Federal funds in the NIH accounting system.

(abbreviation: NoA)
